What you can do to help: Building owners and managers can save birds and energy by turning off unnecessary lights during migration. It's easy and everyone wins! Participants agree to make good-faith efforts to extinguish lighting used at night that is not needed for safety, security, or aviation reasons.

What to do?

- Extinguish exterior decorative lighting
- Eliminate or reduce lobby and atrium lighting
- Turn off interior lights - especially upper stories
- Ask cleaning staff to begin cleaning upper floors first and to work downward

When to do it?

- Between midnight and dawn
- Spring: From April 1 to May 31
- Fall: From August 15 to November 15
